## **Luke 4:14-30**

### Literal Translation

#### **Introduction**

- 14) **And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit unto Galilee; and fame went out according to *the* whole surrounding region concerning Him.**
- 15) **and He himself was teaching in their synagogues, being glorified by all.**
- 16) **and He came unto Nazareth where He was brought up; and He entered into the synagogue, according to His custom, on the day of the Sabbaths, and He stood up to read.**
- 17) **and *the* book of Isaiah the prophet was given to Him. And having unrolled the book He found the place where it was written**

- 18) ***The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, on account of which He anointed me to evangelize the poor; He has sent me to heal the ones having the heart broken; to proclaim forgiveness to the captives, and sight to the blind, to send ones having been broken in forgiveness,***
- 19) **to proclaim *the* acceptable year of *the* Lord.**
- 20) **And having rolled up the book, having delivered *it* to the attendant, He sat down and all eyes in the synagogue were gazing *at* Him.**
- 21) **And He began to say to them that Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your ears.**
- 22) **And all were testifying to Him, and were marveling over the words of grace coming out of His mouth, and they were saying, Is this not the son of Joseph?**

**23) And He said to them, By all means you will say to me this parable, Physician, heal yourself; what things we heard being done in Capernaum, do also here in your fatherland.**

**24) And He said, Truly I say to you that not one prophet is accepted in his fatherland.**

**25) And I say to you *based* upon truth, many widows were in the days of Elijah in Israel, when heaven was shut during three years and six months, when a great famine happened upon all the land.**

**26) And Elijah was sent to not one of them, except unto Zarephath of Sidon to a widow woman.**

**27) And many lepers were in Israel during Elisha the prophet and not one of them was cleansed, except Naaman the Syrian.**

- 28) And all in the synagogue were possessed by rage, while hearing these things.**
- 29) And having risen up they threw Him out of the city, and led Him unto the ledge of the mountain upon which their city had been built, to throw Him down.**
- 30) But He himself, after having passed through the middle of them, was going away.**

## Luke 4:14-30

- 16) **Καὶ ἦλθεν εἰς [τὴν] Ναζαρέθ (Ναζαρά) (Ναζαρέτ), οὗ ἦν τεθραμμένος (ἀντεθραμμένος)· καὶ εἰσῆλθε(ν), κατὰ τὸ εἰωθὸς αὐτῷ, ἐν τῇ ἡμέρᾳ τῶν σαββάτων εἰς τὴν συναγωγὴν, καὶ ἀνέστη ἀναγνῶναι.**  
And He came into [the] Nazareth (Nazareth) (Nazareth), where He was brought up (brought up); and He entered, according to the custom to Him, in the day of the Sabbaths into the synagogue, and He stood up to read.

 Spirit of Lord upon me, of which on account of (on account of) He anointed  
 με εὐαγγελίσασθαι (εὐαγγελίζεσθαι) πτωχοῖς· ἀπέσταλκε(ν) με,  
 me to evangelize (to evangelize) poor; He has sent me,  
 [ἴασασθαι τοὺς συντετριμμένους τὴν καρδίαν·] κηρύξαι

 to proclaim year of Lord acceptable.
- 20) καὶ πτύξας τὸ βιβλίον, ἀποδοὺς τῷ ὑπηρέτῃ,  
 and having rolled up the book, having delivered to the attendant,  
 ἐκάθισε(ν)· καὶ πάντων ἐν τῇ συναγωγῇ οἱ ὀφθαλμοὶ ἦσαν  
 He sat down; and of all in the synagogue the eyes were  
 ἀτενίζοντες αὐτῷ.  
 gazing to Him.
- 21) ἤρξατο δὲ λέγειν πρὸς αὐτοὺς ὅτι Σήμερον πεπλήρωται ἡ  
 He began and to say to them that Today has been fulfilled the

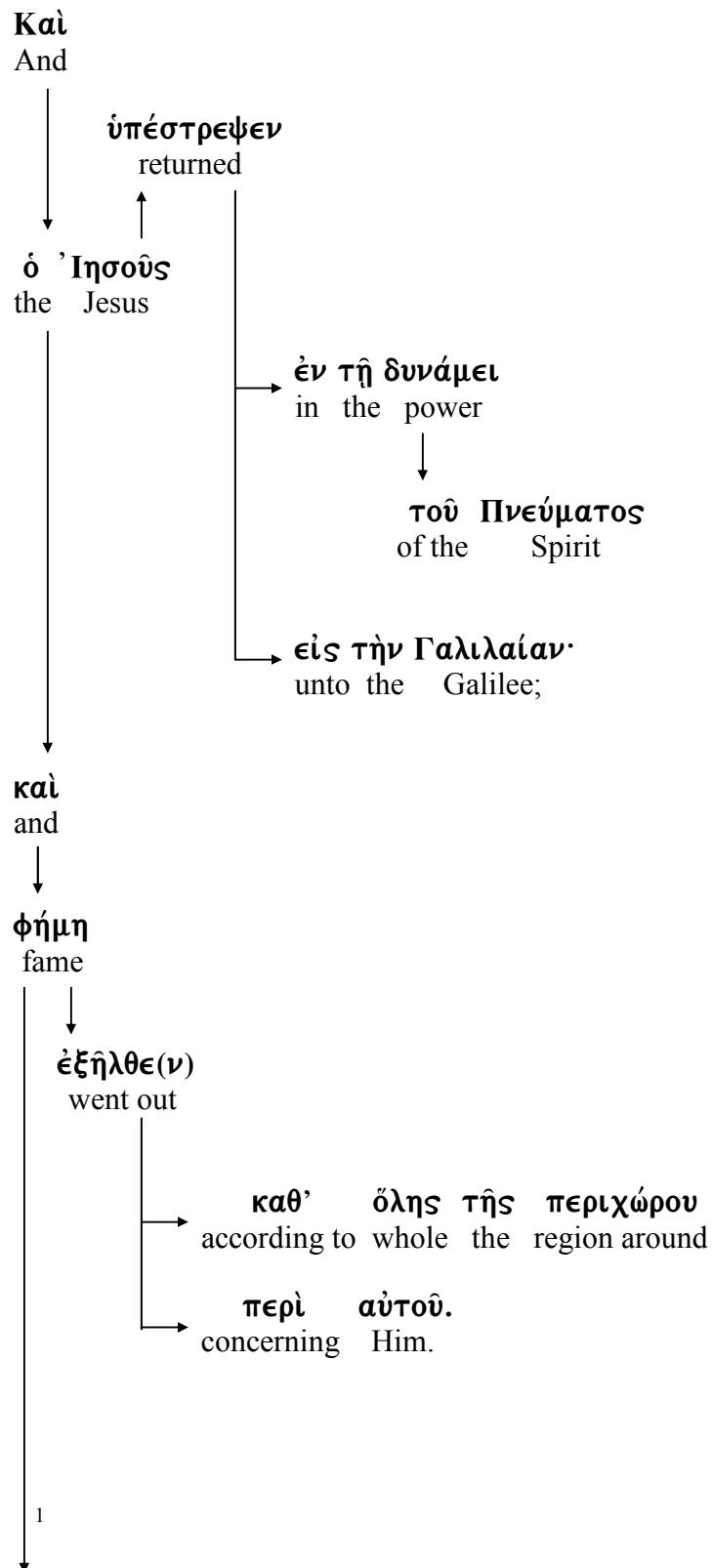
- 23) **καὶ εἶπε(ν) πρὸς αὐτούς, Πάντως ἐρεῖτε μοι τὴν**

- 25) **ἐπ' ἀληθείας δὲ λέγω ὑμῖν, (ὅτι) πολλαὶ χῆραι ἦσαν ἐν ταῖς**  
upon truth and I say to you, (that) many widows were in the  
**ἡμέραις Ἰησοῦ ἐν τῷ Ἰσραήλ, ὅτε ἐκλείσθη ὁ οὐρανὸς ἐπὶ**  
days of Elijah in the Israel, when was shut the heaven upon

years three and months six, when happened famine great upon all

**(Σάρεφθα) τῆς Σιδωνος (Σιδωνίας) πρὸς γυναῖκα χήραν.**  
(Sarephtha) of the Sidon (Sidon) to woman widow.



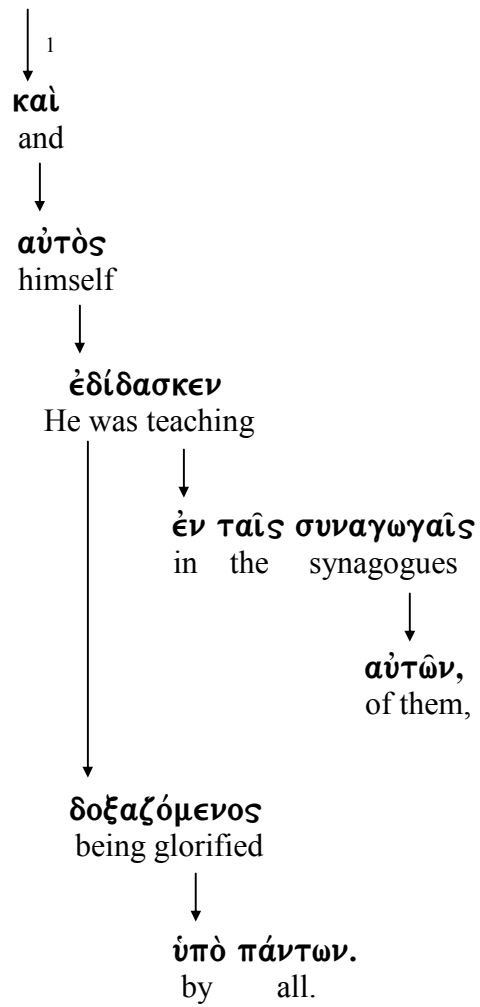
- 27) **καὶ πολλοὶ λεπροὶ ἦσαν (ἐν τῷ Ἰσραὴλ) ἐπὶ Ἐλισαίου τοῦ**  
 and many lepers were (in the Israel) upon Elisha the

- 28) **καὶ ἐπλήσθησαν πάντες θυμοῦ ἐν τῇ συναγωγῇ, ἀκούοντες**  
 and were filled all of rage in the synagogue, while hearing  
**ταῦτα,**  
 these things,
- 29) **καὶ ἀναστάντες ἐξέβαλον αὐτὸν ἔξω τῆς πόλεως, καὶ ἤγαγον**  
 and having risen up they threw Him out of the city, and they led  
**αὐτὸν ἕως (τῆς) ὀφρύος τοῦ ὄρους ἐφ' οὗ ἡ πόλις αὐτῶν**  
 Him unto (the) edge of the mountain upon which the city of them  
**ᾠκοδόμητο (αὐτῶν), (ὥστε) εἰς τὸ κατακρημνίσαι αὐτόν·**  
 had been built (of them), (so that) unto the to throw down Him;
- 30) **αὐτὸς δὲ διελθὼν διὰ μέσου αὐτῶν ἐπορεύετο.**
