Introduction

- 31) Now when *He* took the Twelve aside, He said to them, “See, we are going up unto Jerusalem, and all the things which have been written through the prophets *for* the Son of Man will be fulfilled.

Literal Translation (continued)

- 32) **“For He will be delivered over to the Gentiles, and will be mocked, and will be insulted, and will be spit on.**
- 33) **“And after whipping *Him* they will kill Him; and on the third day He will rise up.**
- 34) **And they themselves understood none of these things, and this saying was hidden from them, and they were not knowing the things being said.**

Literal Translation (continued)

- 35) **Now it happened as He was drawing near unto Jericho, *a* certain blind man was sitting along the road begging;**
- 36) **and when he heard *the* crowd traveling through, he was inquiring what this might be.**
- 37) **And they reported to him that Jesus the Nazarene is passing by.**

- 38) **And he called out, saying, “Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me.”**
