an instant.**

The Retaliation against the Nations

27 ¶ Behold, the name of Yahweh will have come from afar; His anger burning; and *is* heavy *as* smoke; His lips have been full of fury, and His tongue like a devouring fire.

28 And like an overflowing torrent, His breath shall divide to the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity, and a bridle upon the jaws of the people causing to err.

29 The song shall be to you, as the night of making a sanctified festival, and gladness of heart, as one walking with the flute, to come into the mountain of Yahweh, to the Rock of Israel.

30 And Yahweh shall have caused the majesty of His voice to be heard; and He will cause His arm to be seen coming down in raging anger and a flame of consuming fire, cloudburst and storm, and stones of hail.

Joshua 9:1-2

The Preparation for War

1 And it happened, when all the kings which *were* on this side Jordan, in the hill country, and in the valleys, and in all the coast of the great sea facing toward Lebanon, the Hittites, and the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites, had heard;

2 That they gathered themselves together, to fight with Joshua and with Israel, with one unit.

3 And when the inhabitants of Gibeon had heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,

4 that they did work in craftiness, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their donkeys, and wine skins, old, and splitting, and being mended;

5 And old sandals and padded their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provisions had become dry and had become crumbly.

15 And Joshua made peace with them, and he made a covenant with them, to let them live: and the tribal leaders of the congregation swore unto them.

22 And Joshua called for them, and he spoke unto them, saying, "For what have you deceived us, saying, 'We *are* very far from you;' and you were dwelling among us?"
