He shall be raised and He shall have been
lifted up and shall have been made very high.**

Isaiah 53:1
The Call to Notice

1) Who has believed our report? And upon whom has *the* arm of Yahweh been revealed?

Isaiah 53:2
The Characteristics of the Servant

2) And He shall grow up before Him like *a* tender shoot, and like *a* root from out of dry ground. To Him *will be* no form and no majesty and we shall see Him, and *there is* no appearance that we should desire Him.

Isaiah 53:3
The Condition of the Servant

3) *He* being despised and rejected of men, *a* Man of pains, and being acquainted with sickness, and we *were as* hiding *our* faces from Him, *He* being despised, and we had not valued Him.

The Consideration of the Servant

4) Truly He Himself
will have borne our sicknesses,
and our pains He will have carried them;
and we ourselves will have considered
Him being stricken, being smitten of God,
and being afflicted.

5) And He Himself being pierced
from our transgressions;
being crushed from our iniquities;
the chastisement of our peace will have been
upon Him, and in His wounds
He will have given healing to us.

6) All of us like the sheep have gone astray;
we have *each* one turned to his *own* way;
and Yahweh will have put in Him
the iniquity of all of us.

The Compliance of the Servant

**7) He will have been oppressed,
and He being afflicted,
and He will not open His mouth.
He will be led like the lamb to the slaughter;
and as a ewe-lamb before her shearers
will have become silent,
and He will not open His mouth.**

The Course of the Servant

**8) He will have been taken
from confinement and from judgment;
and who shall consider His generation?
Because He will have been cut off
from out of *the* land of *the* living;
from the transgression of My people,
was *a* stroke to Him.**

The Condition of the Servant

**9 And to Him shall be appointed
His tomb with *the* wicked, and with
the rich in His death; although He
will have done no violence, and no
deceit in His mouth.**

The Consequence of the Servant

**10) Now Yahweh will have been
pleased to crush Him,
He will have caused Him to suffer,
when His soul shall make as *a* sin
offering,
He shall see *His* seed;
He shall prolong *His* days;
and the pleasure of Yahweh shall
prosper in His hand.**

**11) He shall see from the travail of
His soul; He shall be satisfied.
In His knowledge shall My
Righteous Servant, justify the
many,
and He Himself shall carry their
iniquities.**

The Conquests of the Servant

**12) Therefore I will divide to Him
a portion among the great,
and He shall divide the spoil
with the strong;
because that He will
pour out His soul to the
death;
and He will have been
numbered with *the*
transgressors;
and He Himself will have lifted
up the sin of many,
and He will intercede for the
transgressors.**
