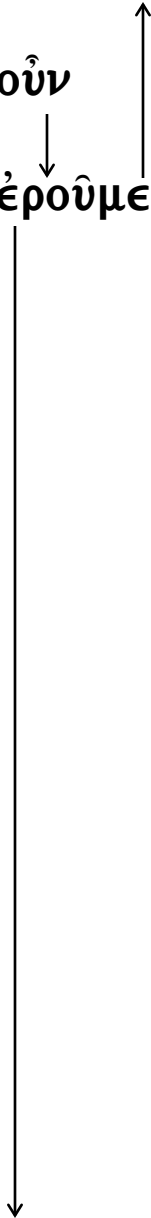

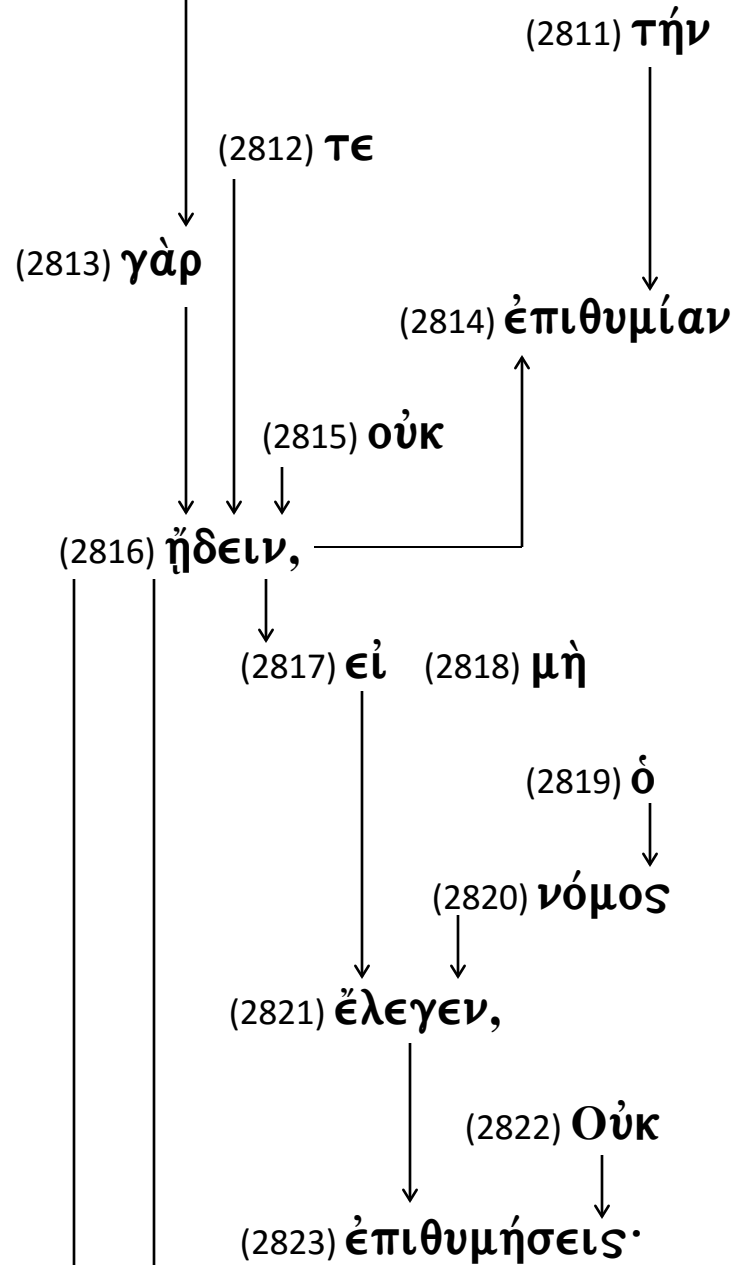

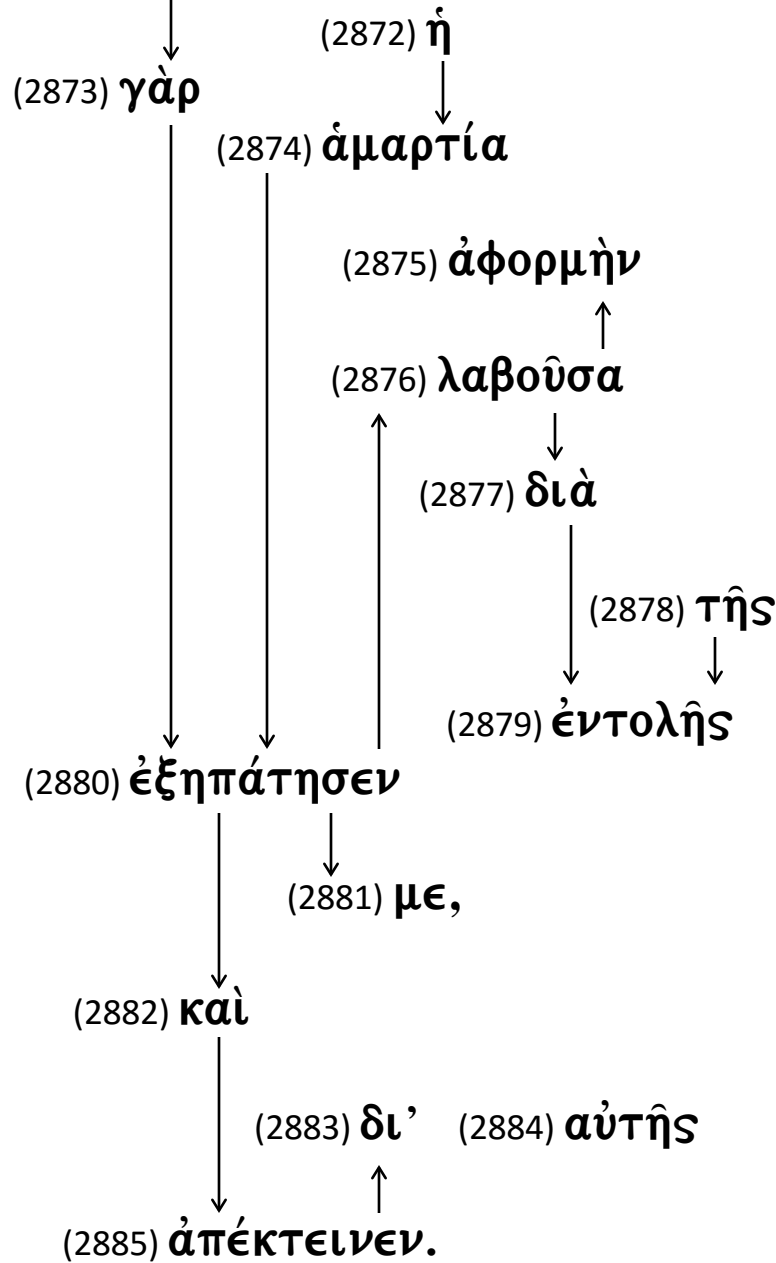

## **I Corinthians 14:33-35**

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## I Corinthians 7:1-7

7 For that I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

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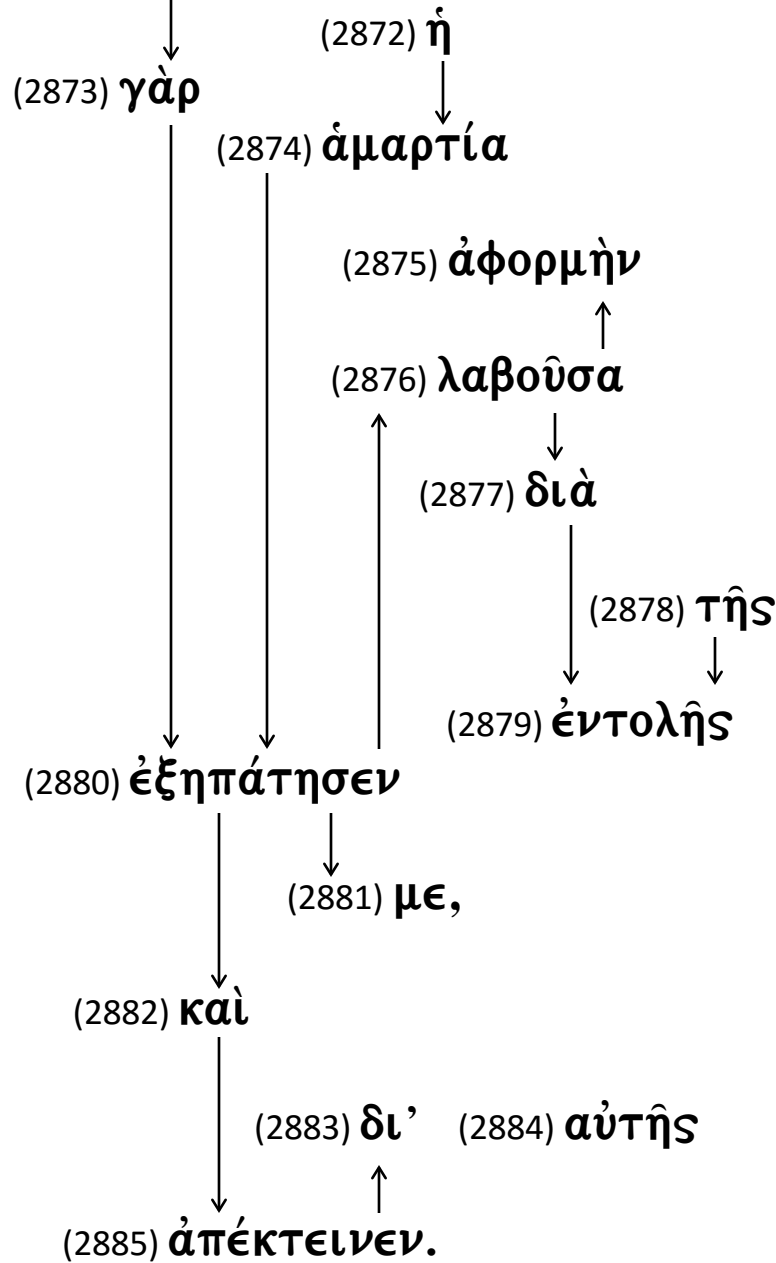
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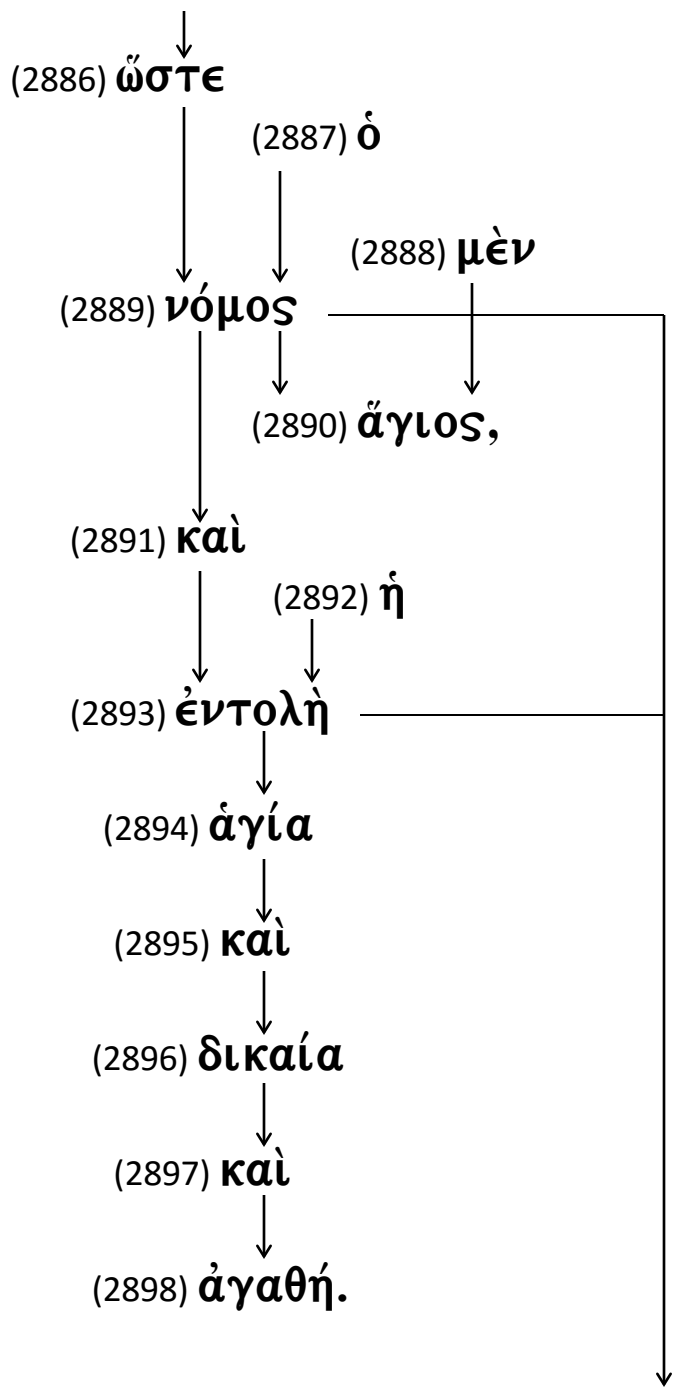
