Romans 8:1: The Position of the Believer

“Then therefore now *there is* not even one judgment against the ones in Christ Jesus, [*the ones* not walking according to flesh but according to Spirit.]”

Romans 8:2: The Conversion of the Believer

"For the law of the Spirit of the life in Christ Jesus freed me from the law of sin and death."

Romans 8:3: The Substitution for the Believer

"For the inability of the law, in which it was weak through the flesh, God having sent His own Son in likeness of flesh of sin, and concerning sin, judged sin in the flesh:"

“In order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, the ones not walking according to flesh, but according to Spirit.”

Romans 8:5-6: The Comparison

5 For the ones being according to flesh are thinking the things of the flesh; and the ones *being* according to Spirit are thinking the things according to Spirit.

6 For the mind of the flesh *is* death; and the mind of the Spirit *is* life and peace.

Verse 7 Rebellion

"On account of that the mind of the flesh *is* hostile toward God:"

Verse 7 Submission

"for it is not being submitted to the law of God,"

Verse 7 Function

"for it is not even able."

Verse 8 Conclusion

"and the ones being in flesh are not able to pleasing to God."

Romans 8:9 The Qualification of the Believer

"But you yourselves are not in flesh, but in Spirit, if indeed *the* Spirit of God is dwelling in you. and if anyone is not having *the* Spirit of Christ, this one is not of Him."

Positional

The preposition "in" denotes the position of authority.

The person who is "in Spirit" is in the position of being under the Law of the Spirit of the Life in Christ Jesus.

This position places the person under the authority and control of the Spirit of Christ, even though the Law of Sin and Death still functions in the flesh.

Dwelling in You

The word for "is dwelling" is

οἰκέω - to dwell, to reside in one's home

from the noun **οἶκος** - a house

The Spirit of God dwells in our body as His home.

Conditional

Of necessity, a person must experience a spiritual birth.

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said unto him, Truly, Truly, I say to you, If anyone should not be born again, he is not able see the kingdom of God.

Titus 3:5

Not from out of works in righteousness which did, but according to his mercy he saved us, through washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Spirit;

This Spiritual Birth is described as receiving Christ.

John 1:12

But as many as received him, He gave to them authority to become children of God, to the ones believing into his name:

Colossians 2:6

As you therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, be walking in him:

The Procedure to Receiving Christ

II Corinthians 6:16-17

¹⁶ And what agreement *has* the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God; according as God said, "I will dwell in them, and walk in *them*; and I will be their God, and they themselves shall be my people.

¹⁷ On account of which come out from out of their midst, and be separated, says *the* Lord, and do not touch *the* unclean *thing*; and I myself will receive you,

¹⁸ And I will be to you for a Father, and you will be to me for sons and daughters, says *the* Lord Almighty.

The Procedure to Receiving Christ (continued)

Ezekiel 11:19-20

¹⁹ And I will give to them one heart, and I will put *a* new spirit within you; and I will have taken the heart of stone from their flesh, and will have given to them *a* heart of flesh:

²⁰ So that they will walk in my statutes, and they will observe My ordinances, and they will have done them: and they will have been to Me *a* people, and I Myself will be to them God.

Ezekiel 36:27

And I will put my spirit within you, and I will have caused you to walk in my statutes, and you will observe my ordinances, and you will have done *them*.

The Procedure to Receiving Christ (continued)

John 14:16-17

¹⁶ And I Myself will request the Father, and another Comforter he will give to you, in order that he might abide with you for ever;

¹⁷ the Spirit of truth; who the world is not able to receive, because it does not view Him, neither is knowing him: but you yourselves are knowing him; He is abiding with you, and shall be in you.

John 14:23

Jesus answered and said to him, If anyone loves me, he will keep my word: and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and we will make *an* abiding place with him.

God sends His Spirit at salvation.

Romans 5:5

And the hope is not making ashamed; because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

Galatians 4:6

And because you are sons, God sent out the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

I Corinthians 12:13

For we all in one Spirit were baptized into one body, whether Jews or Gentiles, whether slaves or free men; and we were all made to drink into one Spirit.

The presence of the Spirit is the guarantee.

Ephesians 1:13-14

¹³ In whom also you, after having heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after having believed, you were sealed *with* the holy Spirit of promise,

¹⁴ Who is *the* guarantee of our inheritance for redemption of the purchased possession, for *the* praise of his glory.

I John 3:24

And the one keeping his commandments is remaining in him, and He in him. And in this we know that he is abiding in us, from out of the Spirit who he gave to us.

I John 4:13

In this we know we that we are abiding in Him, and He in us, because he has given to us from out of His Spirit.

The presence of His Spirit unites us with Him and with one another.

I Corinthians 6:17

But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

John 14:20

At that day ye shall know that I *am* in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.

Galatians 3:28

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female: for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

The Condition of the Believer

Ephesians 3:16

In order that He might give to you, according to the wealth of his glory, that you should be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man;

Ephesians 4:30

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, in which you were sealed for *the* day of redemption.

¹⁴ For as many as are being led *by the* Spirit of God, they are sons of God.

¹⁵ For you did not receive *a* spirit of bondage for fear; but you received *a* Spirit of adoption, in which we are crying, Abba, Father.

Examine yourselves, if you are in the faith; prove yourselves. Or do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you, if not you are disqualified?

The Appeal to Believers

I Corinthians 6:19-20

¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is *the* temple of the Holy Spirit *who is* in you, who you have from God, and you are not your own?

²⁰ For you were bought *with a* price: indeed glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are of God.

II Timothy 1:14

The good thing which was committed to you guard through the Holy Spirit, the One indwelling in us.

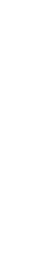
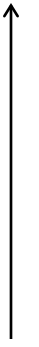
