⁵ For the ones being according to flesh are minding the things of the flesh. And the ones *being* according to Spirit *are minding* the things of the Spirit.

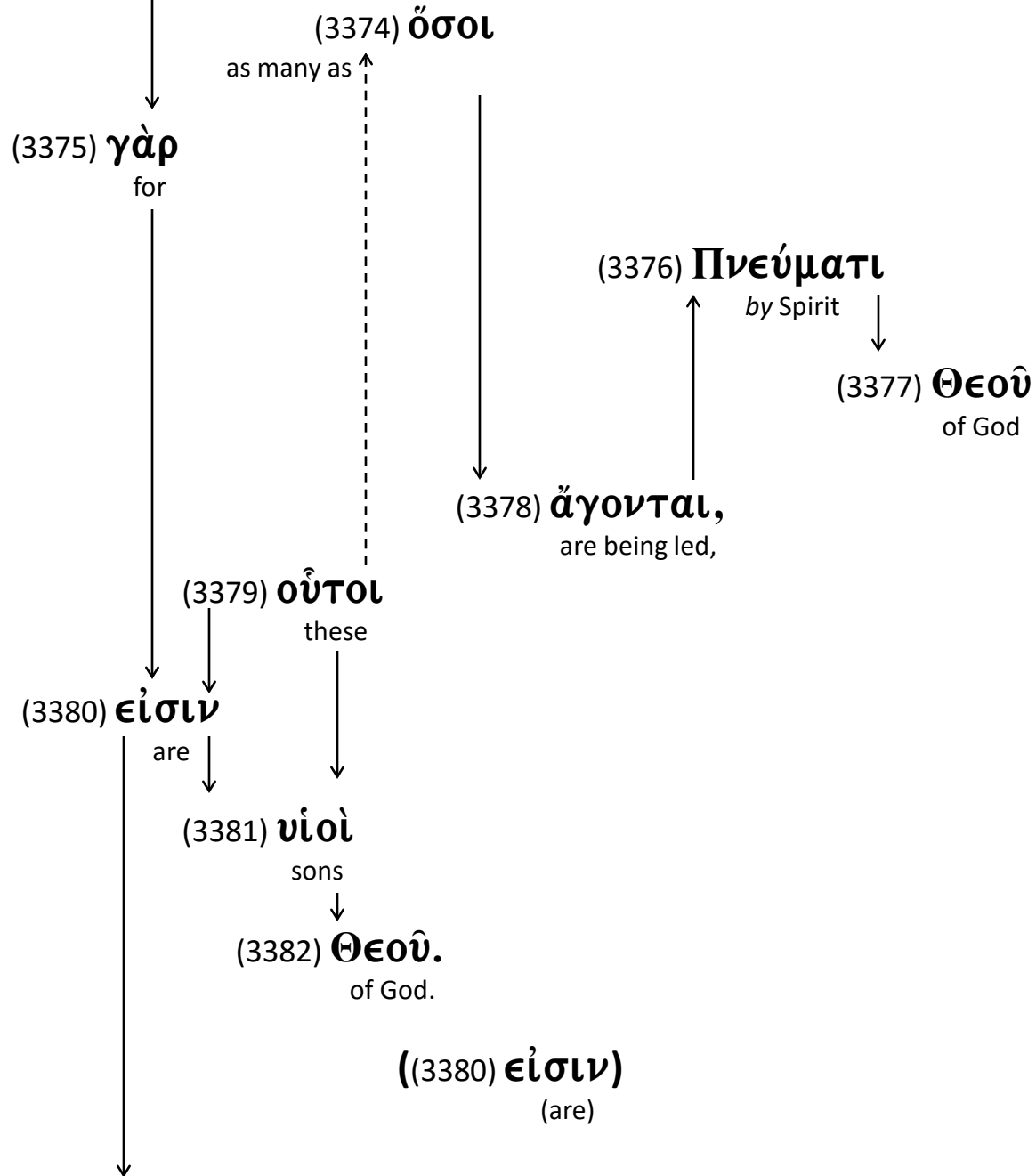

Galatians 4:4-7

⁴ Now when the fullness of the time came, God sent out His Son, having become from out of woman, having become under Law,

⁵ in order that He might redeem the ones under Law, in order that we might receive the adoption.

⁶ And because you are sons, God sent out the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba! Father!

⁷ So that you are no longer are *a* slave, but *a* son, and if *a* son, also *an* heir of God through Christ.
