John Calvin defined predestination by saying,

**"God has once for all determined,
both whom he would admit to salvation,
and whom he would condemn to destruction."**

(Institutes of the Christian Religion, 3:21:181)

Ephesians 1:3-14

does NOT say:

God has chosen and predestinated "us" as unsaved people to hear and believe the Gospel and to be sealed by the Holy Spirit.

but rather it DOES say:

We who have heard and believed the Gospel and who were sealed with the Holy Spirit - God has chosen and predestinated adoption for us and to one day stand before Him Holy and without blemish, for His glory.

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
