The Introduction to the Tomb

1) Now late *in the* sabbaths, while beginning to dawn toward the first of the week, came Mary the Magdalene and the other Mary to view the tomb.

2) And, behold, *a* great earthquake happened: for *an* angel of *the* Lord after having descended from out of heaven, and after having come, he rolled back the stone from the door, and was sitting upon it.

3) Now his appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as if snow:

4) And from the fear of him the ones keeping guard shook and became as if dead *men*.

Matthew 28:5-8

The Interaction at the Tomb

5) And when the angel answered he said to the women, "You yourselves stop fearing: for I know that you are seeking Jesus, the One who had been crucified.

6) "He is not here: for He was raised, according as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord was lying.

7) "And after having gone quickly, say to his disciples that He was raised from the dead; and, behold, He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him: behold, I told you."

8) And after having gone out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, they ran to report to His disciples.

I Corinthians 15:51-58
Literal English Translation

I Corinthians 15:51-58
The Victory Over Death

51) Behold, I speak to you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

52) In an instant, in the twinkling of an eye, in the last trumpet: for a trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we ourselves shall be changed.

53) For it is necessary *for* this corruption to put on incorruption, and this mortal to put on immortality.

54) So, whenever this corruptible should put on incorruption, and this mortal should put on immortality, then shall happen the word which has been written, Death was swallowed up into victory.

55) O death, where *is* your sting? O Hades, where *is* your victory?

56) The sting of death *is* sin; and the power of sin *is* the law.

57) But thanks to God, who is giving to us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

58) So then, my beloved brothers, become firm, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not empty in the Lord.

Literal English Translation

I The Necessity of Death

John 12:23-26

23) And Jesus answered to them, saying, The hour is come, in order that the Son of man should be glorified.

24) Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless the grain of wheat falling into the ground should die, it abides alone: but if it should die, it bears much fruit.

25) The one loving his life shall lose it; and the one hating his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

26) If anyone should serve me, let him follow me; and where I myself am, there will also my servant be: if anyone should serve me, him will *my* Father honor.

Hebrews 4:14

Having therefore a great high priest, who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, we should hold firm *our* confession.

Hebrews 9:11-12

11) But Christ having become a high priest of good things to come, through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not hand made, that is, not of this creation;

12) Neither through the blood of goats and calves, but through his own blood he entered in once into the holies, having found eternal redemption *for us*.

II The Victory Over Physical Death

I Corinthians 15:26

The last enemy *that* is being destroyed *is* death.

Romans 6:9

Knowing that Christ having been raised from out of the dead, dies no more; death no longer rules over Him

John 5:25

Truly, truly, I say to you, that an hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and the ones who have heard shall live.

John 5:28-29

28) Do not marvel at this: because an hour is coming, in which all the ones in the graves shall hear his voice,
29) And shall come out; the ones who have done the good, into a resurrection of life; and the ones who have practiced the corruption, into a resurrection of judgment.

John 6:39-40

39) And this is the will of the Father who sent me, in order that all which he has given me I should not lose from it but should raise it up in the last day.
40) And this is the will of the one who has sent me, in order that everyone seeing the Son, and believeth into him, might have eternal life: and I myself will raise him up in the last day.

III The Victory Over Spiritual Death

Ephesians 2:1-6

- 1) AND you *he made alive*, being dead in trespasses and sins;
- 2) in which once you walked according to the age of this world, according to the ruler of the authority of the air, the spirit now working in the sons of the disobedience:
- 3) Among whom also we ourselves all had our lifestyle once in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as the rest.
- 4) But God, being rich in mercy, on account of his great love which he loved us,
- 5) and we ourselves being dead in trespasses, He made us alive together with Christ, (by grace you are saved;)
- 6) And raised *us* up together, and seated *us* together in heavenlies in Christ Jesus:

Romans 8:11

Now if the Spirit of the one who had raised up Jesus from out of the dead is dwelling in you, the One who had raised up Christ from out of the dead will also make alive your mortal bodies through his Spirit dwelling in you.
