The Protesting of the Scribes and Pharisees

Matthew 15:1-2
The Circumstances

- (1) Then comes to Jesus the scribes and Pharisees from Jerusalem, saying,
- (2) Why do Your disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands whenever they should eat bread.

Matthew 15:3-9
The Confrontation with the Religious Leaders

- (3) But having answered He said to them, Why do you also transgress the commandment of God on account of your tradition?
- (4) For God commanded, saying, "Honor your father and mother," and, "The one speaking evil against father or mother, let him end by death."
- (5) But you yourselves say, Whoever should say to the father or to the mother, A gift, whatever from me you might be profited;
- (6) and he will never honor his father or his mother, And you made void the commandment of God on account of your tradition.
- (7) Hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy concerning you, saying:
- (8) "This people is drawing near to Me with their mouth, and with the lips honor Me; but their heart is far distant from Me.
- (9) But vainly they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men."

- (10) And when he called to the crowd, He said to them, Hear and understand:
- (11) not the thing entering into the mouth is defiling the man, but the thing going out of the mouth, this is defiling the man.

Matthew 15:12-14
The Conflict of the Pharisees

- (12) Then when His disciples came to *Him*, they said to Him, Did you know that the Pharisees after having heard the saying, they were offended?
- (13) But when He answered, He said, Every plant which My heavenly Father did not plant shall be rooted out.
- (14) Leave them *alone*. They are blind leaders of the blind; and if the blind lead the blind, both will fall into *a* pit.

Matthew 15:15-20
The Comprehension of the Problem

- (15) And when Peter answered he said to Him, Explain to us this parable.
- (16) But Jesus said, Are you yourselves also still without understanding?
- (17) Do you not yet perceive that everything going into the mouth goes into the stomach, and is cast out into *the* latrine?

- (19) For out of the heart comes out evil reasonings, murders, adulteries, immoralities, thefts, false testimonies, blasphemies.

My daughter is severely being demonized.
