The Circumstances

**1) And after six days,
Jesus takes alongside
Peter and James,
and John his brother,
and brings them up into a high
mountain privately.**

**2) And He was transformed before them,
and His face did shine like the sun,
and His clothing became white as the light.**

Matthew 17:3-4

The Communication with Moses and Elijah

3) And, behold! Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.

4) And when he answered Peter said to Jesus, Lord, it is good *for* us to be here. If You will, let us make three tents here, one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.

Matthew 17:5-6

The Confirmation from God

5) While he was still speaking, behold, *an* bright cloud overshadowed them. And, behold, *a* voice from out of the cloud saying, This is My Son, the Beloved, in whom I am well-pleased; hear Him.

6) And when they heard, the disciples fell upon their face and were exceedingly afraid.

The Command Concerning the Vision

9) And while they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus gave commandment to them, saying, You should tell the vision to no one until which *time* the Son of Man should rise from out of the dead.

Matthew 17:10-13

The Clarification Concerning Elijah

10) And His disciples questioned Him, saying, Why therefore do the scribes say that Elijah is necessary to come first?

11) And when Jesus answered He said to them, Elijah on the one hand is coming first and will restore all things.

12) But on the other hand I say to you, that Elijah already came, and they did not recognize him, but did in him as much as they desired. This way also the Son of Man is about to suffer by them.

13) Then the disciples understood that He spoke to them concerning John the Baptizer.

The Cause of the Problem

**19) Then when the disciples came to Jesus privately,

For truly I say to you, If you should have faith as a grain
of mustard plant, you will say to this mountain,
Be removed from here to there! And it will be removed.
And nothing will be impossible for you**

Matthew 17:14-21

Supplemental Verses

Matthew 8:5-13

5) Now when Jesus entered into Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, beseeching Him,

6) and saying, Lord, my servant has been laying in the house paralyzed, being grievously tormented.

7) And Jesus says to him, after having come I Myself will heal him.

8) And when *he* answered the centurion said, Lord, I am not sufficient in order that You should enter under my roof, but only speak *a* word and my servant will be healed.

9) For I also am *a* man under authority, having soldiers under myself. And I say to this one, Go; and he goes; and to another one, Come; and he comes; and to my slave, Do this; and he does *it*.

10) And when *He* heard *this* Jesus marveled, and said to the ones following, Truly I say to you, not even in Israel did I find such faith.

11) But I say to you that many will come from east and west, and will recline with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of Heaven,

12) but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of the teeth.

13) And Jesus said to the centurion, Go, and as you believed, let it happen to you. And his servant was healed in that hour.

Matthew 15:21-28

21) And when Jesus went out from there, He withdrew into the parts of Tyre and Sidon.

22) And, behold, when *a* Canaanite woman had come out from those borders she cried out to Him, saying, Have mercy on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely being demonized.

23) But He did not answer to her *a* word. And when His disciples came *to Him* they were asking Him, saying, Send her away, because she cries out after us.

24) But when He answered *He* said, I was not sent except to the lost sheep of *the* house of Israel.

25) But when she came, she was worshipping Him, saying, Lord, help me!

26) But when He answered *He* said, It is not right to take the bread of the children and to throw *it* to the dogs.

27) But she said, Yes, Lord; for even the dogs eat from the crumbs falling from the table of their lords.

28) Then when Jesus Answered *He* said to her, O woman, great is your faith; let it happen to you as you desire. And her daughter was healed from that hour.

Matthew 17:14-21

Supplemental Verses

Matthew 10:1-8

1) And after having called His twelve disciples to Himself, He gave to them authority *over* unclean spirits, so as to cast them out, and to heal every disease and every sickness.

2) Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: First, Simon the one being called Peter and Andrew his brother, James the *son* of Zebedee and John his brother,

3) Philip, and Bartholomew, Thomas, and Matthew the tax-collector, James the *son* of Alpheus, and Lebbaeus, the one having been surnamed Thaddaeus,

4) Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, the one who also had betrayed Him.

5) These twelve Jesus sent out, after having given commandment to them, saying: You should not depart into *the* way of *the* Gentiles, and you should not enter into *a* city of Samaritans.

6) But rather go to the lost sheep of *the* house of Israel.

7) And while going, be preaching, saying, that The kingdom of Heaven has drawn near.

8) Be healing *ones* being weak, be cleansing lepers, be raising *the* dead, be casting out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

Matthew 14:15-18

15) And when it became evening, His disciples came to Him saying, The place is *a* desert, and the hour is already passed. Dismiss the crowds, in order that when they go into the villages they might buy for themselves food.

16) But Jesus said to them, They have no need to go away. You yourselves give to them *food* to eat.

17) But they say to Him, We do not have here except five loaves and two fish.

18) And He said, Bring them here to Me.
